The Scriptures - Torah

Our word for "soul" comes from the Hebrew word nephesh (Hebrew DD) pronounced *neh'-fesh*, Strong's #5315). The King James Version however, translated the word over 16 different ways as follows:

- soul 475
- life 117
- person 29
- mind 15
- heart 15
- creature 9

- body 8
- himself 8
- yourselves 6
- dead 5
- will 4
- desire 4

- man 3
- themselves 3
- any 3
- appetite 2
- misc 47

The actual Hebrew word appears 753 times in the Old Testament. 177 of those occurrences were in the Torah or about 23.51% of all occurrences.

Dr. Strong defines the word *Nephesh* as follows:

- 1) soul, self, life, creature, person, appetite, mind, living being, desire, emotion, passion
 - 1a) that which breathes, the breathing substance or being, soul, the inner being of man
 - 1c) living being (with life in the blood)
 - 1d) the man himself, self, person or individual
 - 1e) seat of the appetites
 - 1f) seat of emotions and passions
 - 1g) activity of mind 1g1) dubious
 - 1h) activity of the will 1h1) dubious
 - 1i) activity of the character 1i1) dubious

- The Actual Torah Scriptures are as follows:
- Genesis 1:20 And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath <05315> life, and fowl that may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven.
- Genesis I:21 And God created great whales, and every living creature <05315> that moveth, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind: and God saw that it was good.
- Genesis 1:24 And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature <05315> after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so.
- Genesis 1:30 And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to every thing that creepeth upon the earth, wherein there is life <05315>, I have given every green herb for meat: and it was so.
- Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul <05315>.
- Genesis 2:19 And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought *them* unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature <05315>, that was the name thereof.
- Genesis 9:4 But flesh with the life <05315> thereof, which is the blood thereof, shall ye not eat.
- Genesis 9:5 And surely your blood of your lives <05315> will I require; at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man's brother will I require the life <05315> of man.
- Genesis 9:10 And with every living creature <05315> that is with you, of the fowl, of the cattle, and of every beast of the earth with you; from all that go out of the ark, to every beast of the earth.
- Genesis 9:12 And God said, This *is* the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every living creature <05315> that *is* with you, for perpetual generations:
- Genesis 9:15 And I will remember my covenant, which is between me and you and every living creature $\leq 0.05315 \geq 0.00$ of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh.
- Genesis 9:16 And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature <05315> of all flesh that is upon the earth.

- Genesis 12:5 And Abram took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother's son, and all their substance that they had gathered, and the souls <05315> that they had gotten in Haran; and they went forth to go into the land of Canaan; and into the land of Canaan they came.
- Genesis 12:13 Say, I pray thee, thou *art* my sister: that it may be well with me for thy sake; and my soul <05315> shall live because of thee.
- Genesis 14:21 And the king of Sodom said unto Abram, Give me the persons <05315>, and take the goods to thyself.
- Genesis 17:14 And the uncircumcised man child whose flesh of his foreskin is not circumcised, that soul <05315> shall be cut off from his people; he hath broken my covenant.
- Genesis 19:17 And it came to pass, when they had brought them forth abroad, that he said, Escape for thy life <05315>; look not behind thee, neither stay thou in all the plain; escape to the mountain, lest thou be consumed.
- Genesis 19:19 Behold now, thy servant hath found grace in thy sight, and thou hast magnified thy mercy, which thou hast shewed unto me in saving my life <05315>; and I cannot escape to the mountain, lest some evil take me, and I die:
- Genesis 19:20 Behold now, this city is near to flee unto, and it is a little one: Oh, let me escape thither, (is it not a little one?) and my soul <05315> shall live.
- Genesis 23:8 And he communed with them, saying, If it be your mind <05315> that I should bury my dead out of my sight; hear me, and intreat for me to Ephron the son of Zohar,
- Genesis 27:4 And make me savoury meat, such as I love, and bring it to me, that I may eat; that my soul <05315> may bless thee before I die.
- Genesis 27:19 And Jacob said unto his father, I am Esau thy firstborn; I have done according as thou badest me: arise, I pray thee, sit and eat of my venison, that thy soul <05315> may bless me.
- Genesis 27:25 And he said, Bring it near to me, and I will eat of my son's venison, that my soul $\leq 0.05315 \geq 1.00$ may bless thee. And he brought it near to him, and he did eat: and he brought him wine, and he drank.
- Genesis 27:31 And he also had made savoury meat, and brought it unto his father, and said unto his father, Let my father arise, and eat of his son's venison, that thy soul <05315> may bless me.
- Genesis 32:30 And Jacob called the name of the place Peniel: for I have seen God face to face, and my life <053 | 5> is preserved.
- Genesis 34:3 And his soul <05315> clave unto Dinah the daughter of Jacob, and he loved the damsel, and spake kindly unto the damsel.

- Genesis 34:8 And Hamor communed with them, saying, The soul <cobases: Saying and Saying
- Genesis 35:18 And it came to pass, as her soul <05315> was in departing, (for she died) that she called his name Benoni: but his father called him Benjamin.
- Genesis 36:6 And Esau took his wives, and his sons, and his daughters, and all the persons <053|5> of his house, and his cattle, and all his beasts, and all his substance, which he had got in the land of Canaan; and went into the country from the face of his brother Jacob.
- Genesis 37:21 And Reuben heard *it*, and he delivered him out of their hands; and said, Let us not kill <05315> him.
- Genesis 42:21 And they said one to another, We are verily guilty concerning our brother, in that we saw the anguish of his soul <05315>, when he besought us, and we would not hear; therefore is this distress come upon us.
- Genesis 44:30 Now therefore when I come to thy servant my father, and the lad be not with us; seeing that his life $\frac{<05315>}{}$ is bound up in the lad's life $\frac{<05315>}{}$;
- Genesis 46:15 These be the sons of Leah, which she bare unto Jacob in Padanaram, with his daughter Dinah: all the souls <05315> of his sons and his daughters were thirty and three.
- Genesis 46:18 These are the sons of Zilpah, whom Laban gave to Leah his daughter, and these she bare unto Jacob, even sixteen souls <05315>.
- Genesis 46:22 These *are* the sons of Rachel, which were born to Jacob: all the souls <05315> were fourteen.
- Genesis 46:25 These are the sons of Bilhah, which Laban gave unto Rachel his daughter, and she bare these unto Jacob: all the souls <05315> were seven.
- Genesis 46:26 All the souls <05315> that came with Jacob into Egypt, which came out of his loins, besides Jacob's sons' wives, all the souls <05315> were threescore and six;
- Genesis 46:27 And the sons of Joseph, which were born him in Egypt, were two souls (05315></u>: all the souls (05315></u> of the house of Jacob, which came into Egypt, were threescore and ten.
- Genesis 49:6 O my soul <05315>, come not thou into their secret; unto their assembly, mine honour, be not thou united: for in their anger they slew a man, and in their selfwill they digged down a wall.
- Exodus 1:5 And all the souls <05315> that came out of the loins of Jacob were seventy souls <05315>: for Joseph was in Egypt already.

- Exodus 4:19 And the LORD said unto Moses in Midian, Go, return into Egypt: for all the men are dead which sought thy life <05315>.
- Exodus 12:4 And if the household be too little for the lamb, let him and his neighbour next unto his house take *it* according to the number of the souls <05315>; every man according to his eating shall make your count for the lamb.
- Exodus 12:15 Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread; even the first day ye shall put away leaven out of your houses: for whosoever eateth leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that soul <05315> shall be cut off from Israel.
- Exodus 12:16 And in the first day there shall be an holy convocation, and in the seventh day there shall be an holy convocation to you; no manner of work shall be done in them, save that which every man <05315> must eat, that only may be done of you.
- Exodus 12:19 Seven days shall there be no leaven found in your houses: for whosoever eateth that which is leavened, even that soul <05315> shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he be a stranger, or born in the land.
- Exodus 15:9 The enemy said, I will pursue, I will overtake, I will divide the spoil; my lust <05315> shall be satisfied upon them; I will draw my sword, my hand shall destroy them.
- Exodus 16:16 This is the thing which the LORD hath commanded, Gather of it every man according to his eating, an omer for every man, according to the number of your persons <05315>; take ye every man for them which are in his tents.
- Exodus 21:23 And if *any* mischief follow, then thou shalt give life <05315> for life <05315>,
- Exodus 21:30 If there be laid on him a sum of money, then he shall give for the ransom of his life <05315> whatsoever is laid upon him.
- Exodus 23:9 Also thou shalt not oppress a stranger: for ye know the heart <05315> of a stranger, seeing ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.
- Exodus 30:12 When thou takest the sum of the children of Israel after their number, then shall they give every man a ransom for his soul <05315> unto the LORD, when thou numberest them; that there be no plague among them, when thou numberest them.
- Exodus 30:15 The rich shall not give more, and the poor shall not give less than half a shekel, when they give an offering unto the LORD, to make an atonement for your souls <05315>.

- Exodus 30:16 And thou shalt take the atonement money of the children of Israel, and shalt appoint it for the service of the tabernacle of the congregation; that it may be a memorial unto the children of Israel before the LORD, to make an atonement for your souls <05315>.
- Exodus 31:14 Ye shall keep the sabbath therefore; for it is holy unto you: every one that defileth it shall surely be put to death: for whosoever doeth any work therein, that soul <05315> shall be cut off from among his people.
- Leviticus 2:1 And when any <05315> will offer a meat offering unto the LORD, his offering shall be of fine flour; and he shall pour oil upon it, and put frankincense thereon:
- Leviticus 4:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If a soul <05315> shall sin through ignorance against any of the commandments of the LORD concerning things which ought not to be done, and shall do against any of them:
- Leviticus 4:27 And if any one <05315> of the common people sin through ignorance, while he doeth somewhat against any of the commandments of the LORD concerning things which ought not to be done, and be guilty;
- Leviticus 5:1 And if a soul $\leq 0.05315 \geq 1.5$ sin, and hear the voice of swearing, and is a witness, whether he hath seen or known of it; if he do not utter it, then he shall bear his iniquity.
- Leviticus 5:2 Or if a soul <05315> touch any unclean thing, whether it be a carcase of an unclean beast, or a carcase of unclean cattle, or the carcase of unclean creeping things, and if it be hidden from him; he also shall be unclean, and guilty.
- Leviticus 5:4 Or if a soul <05315> swear, pronouncing with *his* lips to do evil, or to do good, whatsoever *it* be that a man shall pronounce with an oath, and it be hid from him; when he knoweth *of it*, then he shall be guilty in one of these.
- Leviticus 5:15 If a soul <05315> commit a trespass, and sin through ignorance, in the holy things of the LORD; then he shall bring for his trespass unto the LORD a ram without blemish out of the flocks, with thy estimation by shekels of silver, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for a trespass offering:
- Leviticus 5:17 And if a soul <05315> sin, and commit any of these things which are forbidden to be done by the commandments of the LORD; though he wist it not, yet is he guilty, and shall bear his iniquity.
- Leviticus 6:2 If a soul <05315> sin, and commit a trespass against the LORD, and lie unto his neighbour in that which was delivered him to keep, or in fellowship, or in a thing taken away by violence, or hath deceived his neighbour;

- Leviticus 7:18 And if *any* of the flesh of the sacrifice of his peace offerings be eaten at all on the third day, it shall not be accepted, neither shall it be imputed unto him that offereth it: it shall be an abomination, and the soul <05315> that eateth of it shall bear his iniquity.
- Leviticus 7:20 But the soul <05315> that eateth of the flesh of the sacrifice of peace offerings, that pertain unto the LORD, having his uncleanness upon him, even that soul <05315> shall be cut off from his people.
- Leviticus 7:21 Moreover the soul <05315> that shall touch any unclean thing, as the uncleanness of man, or any unclean beast, or any abominable unclean thing, and eat of the flesh of the sacrifice of peace offerings, which pertain unto the LORD, even that soul <05315> shall be cut off from his people.
- Leviticus 7:25 For whosoever eateth the fat of the beast, of which men offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD, even the soul <05315> that eateth *it* shall be cut off from his people.
- Leviticus 7:27 Whatsoever soul <05315> it be that eateth any manner of blood, even that soul <05315> shall be cut off from his people.
- Leviticus 11:10 And all that have not fins and scales in the seas, and in the rivers, of all that move in the waters, and of any living thing <05315> which is in the waters, they shall be an abomination unto you:
- Leviticus 11:43 Ye shall not make yourselves <05315> abominable with any creeping thing that creepeth, neither shall ye make yourselves unclean with them, that ye should be defiled thereby.
- Leviticus I I:44 For I *am* the LORD your God: ye shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and ye shall be holy; for I *am* holy: neither shall ye defile yourselves <05315> with any manner of creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.
- Leviticus I I:46 This is the law of the beasts, and of the fowl, and of every living creature <05315> that moveth in the waters, and of every creature <05315> that creepeth upon the earth:
- Leviticus 16:29 And this shall be a statute for ever unto you: that in the seventh month, on the tenth day of the month, ye shall afflict your souls <05315>, and do no work at all, whether it be one of your own country, or a stranger that sojourneth among you:
- Leviticus 16:31 It shall be a sabbath of rest unto you, and ye shall afflict your souls <05315>, by a statute for ever.
- Leviticus 17:10 And whatsoever man there be of the house of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn among you, that eateth any manner of blood; I will even set my face against that soul <05315> that eateth blood, and will cut him off from among his people.

- Leviticus 17:11 For the life <05315> of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls <05315>: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul <05315>.
- Leviticus 17:12 Therefore I said unto the children of Israel, No soul <05315> of you shall eat blood, neither shall any stranger that sojourneth among you eat blood.
- Leviticus 17:14 For *it is* the life <05315> of all flesh; the blood of it *is* for the life <05315> thereof: therefore I said unto the children of Israel, Ye shall eat the blood of no manner of flesh: for the life <05315> of all flesh *is* the blood thereof: whosoever eateth it shall be cut off.
- Leviticus 17:15 And every soul <05315> that eateth that which died of itself, or that which was torn with beasts, whether it be one of your own country, or a stranger, he shall both wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and be unclean until the even: then shall he be clean.
- Leviticus 18:29 For whosoever shall commit any of these abominations, even the souls <05315> that commit *them* shall be cut off from among their people.
- Leviticus 19:8 Therefore every one that eateth it shall bear his iniquity, because he hath profaned the hallowed thing of the LORD: and that soul <05315> shall be cut off from among his people.
- Leviticus 19:28 Ye shall not make any cuttings in your flesh for the dead <05315>, nor print any marks upon you: I am the LORD.
- Leviticus 20:6 And the soul <05315> that turneth after such as have familiar spirits, and after wizards, to go a whoring after them, I will even set my face against that soul <05315>, and will cut him off from among his people.
- Leviticus 20:25 Ye shall therefore put difference between clean beasts and unclean, and between unclean fowls and clean: and ye shall not make your souls <053 | 5> abominable by beast, or by fowl, or by any manner of living that creepeth on the ground, which I have separated from you as unclean.
- Leviticus 21:1 And the LORD said unto Moses, Speak unto the priests the sons of Aaron, and say unto them, There shall none be defiled for the dead <05315> among his people:
- Leviticus 21:11 Neither shall he go in to any dead body <05315>, nor defile himself for his father, or for his mother;

- Leviticus 22:3 Say unto them, Whosoever he be of all your seed among your generations, that goeth unto the holy things, which the children of Israel hallow unto the LORD, having his uncleanness upon him, that soul <05315> shall be cut off from my presence: I am the LORD.
- Leviticus 22:4 What man soever of the seed of Aaron *is* a leper, or hath a running issue; he shall not eat of the holy things, until he be clean. And whoso toucheth any thing *that is* unclean *by* the dead <05315>, or a man whose seed goeth from him;
- Leviticus 22:6 The soul <05315> which hath touched any such shall be unclean until even, and shall not eat of the holy things, unless he wash his flesh with water.
- Leviticus 22:11 But if the priest buy *any* soul <05315> with his money, he shall eat of it, and he that is born in his house: they shall eat of his meat.
- Leviticus 23:27 Also on the tenth *day* of this seventh month *there shall be* a day of atonement: it shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls <05315>, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.
- Leviticus 23:29 For whatsoever soul <05315> it be that shall not be afflicted in that same day, he shall be cut off from among his people.
- Leviticus 23:30 And whatsoever soul $\leq 0.05315 \geq it$ be that doeth any work in that same day, the same soul $\leq 0.05315 \geq it$ will I destroy from among his people.
- Leviticus 23:32 It *shall* be unto you a sabbath of rest, and ye shall afflict your souls <05315>: in the ninth *day* of the month at even, from even unto even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath.
- Leviticus 24:17 And he that killeth any <05315> man shall surely be put to death.
- Leviticus 24:18 And he that killeth a beast <05315> shall make it good; beast <05315> for beast <05315>.
- Leviticus 26:11 And I will set my tabernacle among you: and my soul <05315> shall not abhor you.
- Leviticus 26:15 And if ye shall despise my statutes, or if your soul <05315> abhor my judgments, so that ye will not do all my commandments, but that ye break my covenant:
- Leviticus 26:16 I also will do this unto you; I will even appoint over you terror, consumption, and the burning ague, that shall consume the eyes, and cause sorrow of heart <05315>: and ye shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it.

- Leviticus 26:30 And I will destroy your high places, and cut down your images, and cast your carcases upon the carcases of your idols, and my soul <05315> shall abhor you.
- Leviticus 26:43 The land also shall be left of them, and shall enjoy her sabbaths, while she lieth desolate without them: and they shall accept of the punishment of their iniquity: because, even because they despised my judgments, and because their soul <05315> abhorred my statutes.
- Leviticus 27:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When a man shall make a singular vow, the persons <05315> shall be for the LORD by thy estimation.
- Numbers 5:2 Command the children of Israel, that they put out of the camp every leper, and every one that hath an issue, and whosoever is defiled by the dead <05315>:
- Numbers 5:6 Speak unto the children of Israel, When a man or woman shall commit any sin that men commit, to do a trespass against the LORD, and that person <05315> be guilty;
- Numbers 6:6 All the days that he separateth *himself* unto the LORD he shall come at no dead body <05315>.
- Numbers 6:11 And the priest shall offer the one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering, and make an atonement for him, for that he sinned by the dead <05315>, and shall hallow his head that same day.
- Numbers 9:6 And there were certain men, who were defiled by the dead body <05315> of a man, that they could not keep the passover on that day: and they came before Moses and before Aaron on that day:
- Numbers 9:7 And those men said unto him, We are defiled by the dead body <05315> of a man: wherefore are we kept back, that we may not offer an offering of the LORD in his appointed season among the children of Israel?
- Numbers 9:10 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If any man of you or of your posterity shall be unclean by reason of a dead body <0.5315>, or be in a journey afar off, yet he shall keep the passover unto the LORD.
- Numbers 9:13 But the man that is clean, and is not in a journey, and forbeareth to keep the passover, even the same soul <05315> shall be cut off from among his people: because he brought not the offering of the LORD in his appointed season, that man shall bear his sin.
- Numbers 11:6 But now our soul <05315> is dried away: there is nothing at all, beside this manna, before our eyes.
- Numbers 15:27 And if any soul $\leq 0.05315 \geq 0.05$ sin through ignorance, then he shall bring a she goat of the first year for a sin offering.

- Numbers 15:28 And the priest shall make an atonement for the soul <05315> that sinneth ignorantly, when he sinneth by ignorance before the LORD, to make an atonement for him; and it shall be forgiven him.
- Numbers 15:30 But the soul <05315> that doeth *ought* presumptuously, whether he be born in the land, or a stranger, the same reproacheth the LORD; and that soul <05315> shall be cut off from among his people.
- Numbers 15:31 Because he hath despised the word of the LORD, and hath broken his commandment, that soul <05315> shall utterly be cut off; his iniquity shall be upon him.
- Numbers 16:38 The censers of these sinners against their own souls <05315>, let them make them broad plates *for* a covering of the altar: for they offered them before the LORD, therefore they are hallowed: and they shall be a sign unto the children of Israel.
- Numbers 19:11 He that toucheth the dead body <05315> of any man shall be unclean seven days.
- Numbers 19:13 Whosoever toucheth the dead body <05315> of any man that is dead, and purifieth not himself, defileth the tabernacle of the LORD; and that soul <05315> shall be cut off from Israel: because the water of separation was not sprinkled upon him, he shall be unclean; his uncleanness is yet upon him.
- Numbers 19:18 And a clean person shall take hyssop, and dip it in the water, and sprinkle it upon the tent, and upon all the vessels, and upon the persons <05315> that were there, and upon him that touched a bone, or one slain, or one dead, or a grave:
- Numbers 19:20 But the man that shall be unclean, and shall not purify himself, that soul <05315> shall be cut off from among the congregation, because he hath defiled the sanctuary of the LORD: the water of separation hath not been sprinkled upon him; he *is* unclean.
- Numbers 19:22 And whatsoever the unclean *person* toucheth shall be unclean; and the soul <05315> that toucheth *it* shall be unclean until even.
- Numbers 21:4 And they journeyed from mount Hor by the way of the Red sea, to compass the land of Edom: and the soul <05315> of the people was much discouraged because of the way.
- Numbers 21:5 And the people spake against God, and against Moses, Wherefore have ye brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? for there is no bread, neither is there any water; and our soul <05315> loatheth this light bread.

- Numbers 23:10 Who can count the dust of Jacob, and the number of the fourth *part* of Israel? Let me die <05315> the death of the righteous, and let my last end be like his!
- Numbers 29:7 And ye shall have on the tenth *day* of this seventh month an holy convocation; and ye shall afflict your souls <05315>: ye shall not do any work *therein*:
- Numbers 30:2 If a man vow a vow unto the LORD, or swear an oath to bind his soul <05315> with a bond; he shall not break his word, he shall do according to all that proceedeth out of his mouth.
- Numbers 30:4 And her father hear her vow, and her bond wherewith she hath bound her soul <05315>, and her father shall hold his peace at her: then all her vows shall stand, and every bond wherewith she hath bound her soul <05315> shall stand.
- Numbers 30:5 But if her father disallow her in the day that he heareth; not any of her vows, or of her bonds wherewith she hath bound her soul <05315>, shall stand: and the LORD shall forgive her, because her father disallowed her.
- Numbers 30:6 And if she had at all an husband, when she vowed, or uttered ought out of her lips, wherewith she bound her soul <05315>;
- Numbers 30:7 And her husband heard it, and held his peace at her in the day that he heard it: then her vows shall stand, and her bonds wherewith she bound her soul <05315> shall stand.
- Numbers 30:8 But if her husband disallowed her on the day that he heard *it*; then he shall make her vow which she vowed, and that which she uttered with her lips, wherewith she bound her soul <05315>, of none effect: and the LORD shall forgive her.
- Numbers 30:9 But every vow of a widow, and of her that is divorced, wherewith they have bound their souls <05315>, shall stand against her.
- Numbers 30:10 And if she vowed in her husband's house, or bound her soul <05315> by a bond with an oath;
- Numbers 30:11 And her husband heard *it*, and held his peace at her, *and* disallowed her not: then all her vows shall stand, and every bond wherewith she bound her soul <05315> shall stand.
- Numbers 30:12 But if her husband hath utterly made them void on the day he heard *them*; *then* whatsoever proceeded out of her lips concerning her vows, or concerning the bond of her soul <05315>, shall not stand: her husband hath made them void; and the LORD shall forgive her.
- Numbers 30:13 Every vow, and every binding oath to afflict the soul <05315>, her husband may establish it, or her husband may make it void.

- Numbers 31:19 And do ye abide without the camp seven days: whosoever hath killed any person <05315>, and whosoever hath touched any slain, purify *both* yourselves and your captives on the third day, and on the seventh day.
- Numbers 31:28 And levy a tribute unto the LORD of the men of war which went out to battle: one soul <05315> of five hundred, *both* of the persons, and of the beeves, and of the asses, and of the sheep:
- Numbers 31:35 And thirty and two thousand persons <05315> in all, of women that had not known man by lying with him.
- Numbers 31:40 And the persons <05315> were sixteen thousand; of which the LORD'S tribute was thirty and two persons <05315>.
- Numbers 31:46 And sixteen thousand persons <05315>;)
- Numbers 31:50 We have therefore brought an oblation for the LORD, what every man hath gotten, of jewels of gold, chains, and bracelets, rings, earrings, and tablets, to make an atonement for our souls <05315> before the LORD.
- Numbers 35:11 Then ye shall appoint you cities to be cities of refuge for you; that the slayer may flee thither, which killeth any person <05315> at unawares.
- Numbers 35:15 These six cities shall be a refuge, *both* for the children of Israel, and for the stranger, and for the sojourner among them: that every one that killeth any person <05315> unawares may flee thither.
- Numbers 35:30 Whoso killeth any person $\leq 0.5315 >$, the murderer shall be put to death by the mouth of witnesses: but one witness shall not testify against any person $\leq 0.5315 >$ to cause him to die.
- Numbers 35:31 Moreover ye shall take no satisfaction for the life <05315> of a murderer, which *is* guilty of death: but he shall be surely put to death.
- Deuteronomy 4:9 Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul <05315> diligently, lest thou forget the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life: but teach them thy sons, and thy sons' sons;
- Deuteronomy 4:15 Take ye therefore good heed unto yourselves <05315>; for ye saw no manner of similitude on the day that the LORD spake unto you in Horeb out of the midst of the fire:
- Deuteronomy 4:29 But if from thence thou shalt seek the LORD thy God, thou shalt find *him*, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul <05315>.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul <05315>, and with all thy might.

- Deuteronomy 10:12 And now, Israel, what doth the LORD thy God require of thee, but to fear the LORD thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the LORD thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul <05315>,
- Deuteronomy 10:22 Thy fathers went down into Egypt with threescore and ten persons <05315>; and now the LORD thy God hath made thee as the stars of heaven for multitude.
- Deuteronomy 11:13 And it shall come to pass, if ye shall hearken diligently unto my commandments which I command you this day, to love the LORD your God, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul <05315>,
- Deuteronomy 11:18 Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul <05315>, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes.
- Deuteronomy 12:15 Notwithstanding thou mayest kill and eat flesh in all thy gates, whatsoever thy soul <05315> lusteth after, according to the blessing of the LORD thy God which he hath given thee: the unclean and the clean may eat thereof, as of the roebuck, and as of the hart.
- Deuteronomy 12:20 When the LORD thy God shall enlarge thy border, as he hath promised thee, and thou shalt say, I will eat flesh, because thy soul <05315> longeth to eat flesh; thou mayest eat flesh, whatsoever thy soul <05315> lusteth after.
- Deuteronomy 12:21 If the place which the LORD thy God hath chosen to put his name there be too far from thee, then thou shalt kill of thy herd and of thy flock, which the LORD hath given thee, as I have commanded thee, and thou shalt eat in thy gates whatsoever thy soul <05315> lusteth after.
- Deuteronomy 12:23 Only be sure that thou eat not the blood: for the blood is the life <05315>; and thou mayest not eat the life <05315> with the flesh.
- Deuteronomy 13:3 Thou shalt not hearken unto the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: for the LORD your God proveth you, to know whether ye love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul <05315>.
- Deuteronomy 13:6 If thy brother, the son of thy mother, or thy son, or thy daughter, or the wife of thy bosom, or thy friend, which is as thine own soul <05315>, entice thee secretly, saying, Let us go and serve other gods, which thou hast not known, thou, nor thy fathers;

- Deuteronomy 14:26 And thou shalt bestow that money for whatsoever thy soul <05315> lusteth after, for oxen, or for sheep, or for wine, or for strong drink, or for whatsoever thy soul <05315> desireth: and thou shalt eat there before the LORD thy God, and thou shalt rejoice, thou, and thine household,
- Deuteronomy 18:6 And if a Levite come from any of thy gates out of all Israel, where he sojourned, and come with all the desire of his mind <05315> unto the place which the LORD shall choose;
- Deuteronomy 19:6 Lest the avenger of the blood pursue the slayer, while his heart is hot, and overtake him, because the way is long, and slay him <05315>; whereas he was not worthy of death, inasmuch as he hated him not in time past.
- Deuteronomy 19:11 But if any man hate his neighbour, and lie in wait for him, and rise up against him, and smite him mortally <05315> that he die, and fleeth into one of these cities:
- Deuteronomy 19:21 And thine eye shall not pity; but life $\leq 05315 \geq$ shall go for life $\leq 05315 \geq$, eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot.
- Deuteronomy 21:14 And it shall be, if thou have no delight in her, then thou shalt let her go whither she will <05315>; but thou shalt not sell her at all for money, thou shalt not make merchandise of her, because thou hast humbled her.
- Deuteronomy 22:26 But unto the damsel thou shalt do nothing; there is in the damsel no sin worthy of death: for as when a man riseth against his neighbour, and slayeth <05315> him, even so is this matter:
- Deuteronomy 23:24 When thou comest into thy neighbour's vineyard, then thou mayest eat grapes thy fill at thine own pleasure <05315>; but thou shalt not put *any* in thy vessel.
- Deuteronomy 24:6 No man shall take the nether or the upper millstone to pledge: for he taketh a man's life <0.5315> to pledge.
- Deuteronomy 24:7 If a man be found stealing any <05315> of his brethren of the children of Israel, and maketh merchandise of him, or selleth him; then that thief shall die; and thou shalt put evil away from among you.
- Deuteronomy 24:15 At his day thou shalt give him his hire, neither shall the sun go down upon it; for he is poor, and setteth his heart <05315> upon it: lest he cry against thee unto the LORD, and it be sin unto thee.
- Deuteronomy 26:16 This day the LORD thy God hath commanded thee to do these statutes and judgments: thou shalt therefore keep and do them with all thine heart, and with all thy soul <05315>.

- Deuteronomy 27:25 Cursed be he that taketh reward to slay an innocent person <05315>. And all the people shall say, Amen.
- Deuteronomy 28:65 And among these nations shalt thou find no ease, neither shall the sole of thy foot have rest: but the LORD shall give thee there a trembling heart, and failing of eyes, and sorrow of mind <05315>:
- Deuteronomy 30:2 And shalt return unto the LORD thy God, and shalt obey his voice according to all that I command thee this day, thou and thy children, with all thine heart, and with all thy soul <05315>;
- Deuteronomy 30:6 And the LORD thy God will circumcise thine heart, and the heart of thy seed, to love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul <05315>, that thou mayest live.
- Deuteronomy 30:10 If thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his commandments and his statutes which are written in this book of the law, *and* if thou turn unto the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul <05315>.

The Scriptures - History

- Joshua 2:13 And *that* ye will save alive my father, and my mother, and my brethren, and my sisters, and all that they have, and deliver our lives <05315> from death.
- Joshua 2:14 And the men answered her, Our life <05315> for yours, if ye utter not this our business. And it shall be, when the LORD hath given us the land, that we will deal kindly and truly with thee.
- Joshua 9:24 And they answered Joshua, and said, Because it was certainly told thy servants, how that the LORD thy God commanded his servant Moses to give you all the land, and to destroy all the inhabitants of the land from before you, therefore we were sore afraid of our lives <05315> because of you, and have done this thing.
- Joshua 10:28 And that day Joshua took Makkedah, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and the king thereof he utterly destroyed, them, and all the souls <05315> that were therein; he let none remain: and he did to the king of Makkedah as he did unto the king of Jericho.
- Joshua 10:30 And the LORD delivered it also, and the king thereof, into the hand of Israel; and he smote it with the edge of the sword, and all the souls <05315> that were therein; he let none remain in it; but did unto the king thereof as he did unto the king of Jericho.
- Joshua 10:32 And the LORD delivered Lachish into the hand of Israel, which took it on the second day, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and all the souls <05315> that were therein, according to all that he had done to Libnah.
- Joshua 10:35 And they took it on that day, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and all the souls <05315> that were therein he utterly destroyed that day, according to all that he had done to Lachish.
- Joshua 10:37 And they took it, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and the king thereof, and all the cities thereof, and all the souls <05315> that were therein; he left none remaining, according to all that he had done to Eglon; but destroyed it utterly, and all the souls <05315> that were therein.

- Joshua 10:39 And he took it, and the king thereof, and all the cities thereof; and they smote them with the edge of the sword, and utterly destroyed all the souls <05315> that were therein; he left none remaining: as he had done to Hebron, so he did to Debir, and to the king thereof; as he had done also to Libnah, and to her king.
- Joshua II:II And they smote all the souls <05315> that were therein with the edge of the sword, utterly destroying them: there was not any left to breathe: and he burnt Hazor with fire.
- Joshua 20:3 That the slayer that killeth *any* person <05315> unawares *and* unwittingly may flee thither: and they shall be your refuge from the avenger of blood.
- Joshua 20:9 These were the cities appointed for all the children of Israel, and for the stranger that sojourneth among them, that whosoever killeth *any* person <05315> at unawares might flee thither, and not die by the hand of the avenger of blood, until he stood before the congregation.
- Joshua 22:5 But take diligent heed to do the commandment and the law, which Moses the servant of the LORD charged you, to love the LORD your God, and to walk in all his ways, and to keep his commandments, and to cleave unto him, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul <05315>.
- Joshua 23:11 Take good heed therefore unto yourselves <05315>, that ye love the LORD your God.
- Joshua 23:14 And, behold, this day I am going the way of all the earth: and ye know in all your hearts and in all your souls <05315>, that not one thing hath failed of all the good things which the LORD your God spake concerning you; all are come to pass unto you, and not one thing hath failed thereof.
- Judges 5:18 Zebulun and Naphtali were a people that jeoparded their lives <05315> unto the death in the high places of the field.
- Judges 5:21 The river of Kishon swept them away, that ancient river, the river Kishon. O my soul <05315>, thou hast trodden down strength.
- Judges 9:17 (For my father fought for you, and adventured his life <05315> far, and delivered you out of the hand of Midian:
- Judges 10:16 And they put away the strange gods from among them, and served the LORD: and his soul <05315> was grieved for the misery of Israel.

- Judges 12:3 And when I saw that ye delivered me not, I put my life <05315> in my hands, and passed over against the children of Ammon, and the LORD delivered them into my hand: wherefore then are ye come up unto me this day, to fight against me?
- Judges 16:16 And it came to pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, so that his soul <05315> was vexed unto death;
- Judges 16:30 And Samson said, Let me die <05315> with the Philistines. And he bowed himself with *all his* might; and the house fell upon the lords, and upon all the people that were therein. So the dead which he slew at his death were more than *they* which he slew in his life.
- Judges 18:25 And the children of Dan said unto him, Let not thy voice be heard among us, lest angry <05315> fellows run upon thee, and thou lose thy life <05315>, with the lives <05315> of thy household.
- Ruth 4:15 And he shall be unto thee a restorer of *thy* life <05315>, and a nourisher of thine old age: for thy daughter in law, which loveth thee, which is better to thee than seven sons, hath born him.
- I Samuel 1:10 And she was in bitterness of soul <05315>, and prayed unto the LORD, and wept sore.
- I Samuel 1:15 And Hannah answered and said, No, my lord, I am a woman of a sorrowful spirit: I have drunk neither wine nor strong drink, but have poured out my soul <05315> before the LORD.
- I Samuel I:26 And she said, Oh my lord, as thy soul <05315> liveth, my lord, I am the woman that stood by thee here, praying unto the LORD.
- I Samuel 2:16 And if any man said unto him, Let them not fail to burn the fat presently, and then take as much as thy soul <05315> desireth; then he would answer him, Nay; but thou shalt give it me now: and if not, I will take it by force.
- I Samuel 2:33 And the man of thine, whom I shall not cut off from mine altar, shall be to consume thine eyes, and to grieve thine heart <05315>: and all the increase of thine house shall die in the flower of their age.
- I Samuel 2:35 And I will raise me up a faithful priest, that shall do according to that which is in mine heart and in my mind <05315>: and I will build him a sure house; and he shall walk before mine anointed for ever.
- I Samuel 17:55 And when Saul saw David go forth against the Philistine, he said unto Abner, the captain of the host, Abner, whose son is this youth? And Abner said, As thy soul <05315> liveth, O king, I cannot tell.
- I Samuel 18:1 And it came to pass, when he had made an end of speaking unto Saul, that the soul <05315> of Jonathan was knit with the soul <05315> of David, and Jonathan loved him as his own soul <05315>.

- I Samuel 18:3 Then Jonathan and David made a covenant, because he loved him as his own soul <05315>.
- I Samuel 19:5 For he did put his life <05315> in his hand, and slew the Philistine, and the LORD wrought a great salvation for all Israel: thou sawest it, and didst rejoice: wherefore then wilt thou sin against innocent blood, to slay David without a cause?
- I Samuel 19:11 Saul also sent messengers unto David's house, to watch him, and to slay him in the morning: and Michal David's wife told him, saying, If thou save not thy life <05315> to night, to morrow thou shalt be slain.
- I Samuel 20:1 And David fled from Naioth in Ramah, and came and said before Jonathan, What have I done? what is mine iniquity? and what is my sin before thy father, that he seeketh my life <05315>?
- I Samuel 20:3 And David sware moreover, and said, Thy father certainly knoweth that I have found grace in thine eyes; and he saith, Let not Jonathan know this, lest he be grieved: but truly as the LORD liveth, and as thy soul <05315> liveth, there is but a step between me and death.
- I Samuel 20:4 Then said Jonathan unto David, Whatsoever thy soul <05315> desireth, I will even do it for thee.
- I Samuel 20:17 And Jonathan caused David to swear again, because he loved him: for he loved him as he loved his own soul <05315>.
- I Samuel 22:2 And every one *that was* in distress, and every one that *was* in debt, and every one *that was* discontented <05315>, gathered themselves unto him; and he became a captain over them: and there were with him about four hundred men.
- I Samuel 22:22 And David said unto Abiathar, I knew it that day, when Doeg the Edomite was there, that he would surely tell Saul: I have occasioned the death of all the persons <05315> of thy father's house.
- I Samuel 22:23 Abide thou with me, fear not: for he that seeketh my life <05315> seeketh thy life <05315>: but with me thou shalt be in safeguard.
- I Samuel 23:15 And David saw that Saul was come out to seek his life <05315>: and David was in the wilderness of Ziph in a wood.
- I Samuel 23:20 Now therefore, O king, come down according to all the desire of thy soul <05315> to come down; and our part shall be to deliver him into the king's hand.
- I Samuel 24:11 Moreover, my father, see, yea, see the skirt of thy robe in my hand: for in that I cut off the skirt of thy robe, and killed thee not, know thou and see that *there is* neither evil nor transgression in mine hand, and I have not sinned against thee; yet thou huntest my soul <05315> to take it.

- I Samuel 25:26 Now therefore, my lord, as the LORD liveth, and as thy soul <05315> liveth, seeing the LORD hath withholden thee from coming to shed blood, and from avenging thyself with thine own hand, now let thine enemies, and they that seek evil to my lord, be as Nabal.
- I Samuel 25:29 Yet a man is risen to pursue thee, and to seek thy soul <05315>: but the soul <05315> of my lord shall be bound in the bundle of life with the LORD thy God; and the souls <05315> of thine enemies, them shall he sling out, as out of the middle of a sling.
- I Samuel 26:21 Then said Saul, I have sinned: return, my son David: for I will no more do thee harm, because my soul <05315> was precious in thine eyes this day: behold, I have played the fool, and have erred exceedingly.
- I Samuel 26:24 And, behold, as thy life <05315> was much set by this day in mine eyes, so let my life <05315> be much set by in the eyes of the LORD, and let him deliver me out of all tribulation.
- I Samuel 28:9 And the woman said unto him, Behold, thou knowest what Saul hath done, how he hath cut off those that have familiar spirits, and the wizards, out of the land: wherefore then layest thou a snare for my life <05315>, to cause me to die?
- I Samuel 28:21 And the woman came unto Saul, and saw that he was sore troubled, and said unto him, Behold, thine handmaid hath obeyed thy voice, and I have put my life <05315> in my hand, and have hearkened unto thy words which thou spakest unto me.
- I Samuel 30:6 And David was greatly distressed; for the people spake of stoning him, because the soul <05315> of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and for his daughters: but David encouraged himself in the LORD his God.
- 2 Samuel 1:9 He said unto me again, Stand, I pray thee, upon me, and slay me: for anguish is come upon me, because my life <05315> is yet whole in me.
- 2 Samuel 3:21 And Abner said unto David, I will arise and go, and will gather all Israel unto my lord the king, that they may make a league with thee, and that thou mayest reign over all that thine heart <05315> desireth. And David sent Abner away; and he went in peace.
- 2 Samuel 4:8 And they brought the head of Ishbosheth unto David to Hebron, and said to the king, Behold the head of Ishbosheth the son of Saul thine enemy, which sought thy life <05315>; and the LORD hath avenged my lord the king this day of Saul, and of his seed.
- 2 Samuel 4:9 And David answered Rechab and Baanah his brother, the sons of Rimmon the Beerothite, and said unto them, As the LORD liveth, who hath redeemed my soul <05315> out of all adversity,

- 2 Samuel 5:8 And David said on that day, Whosoever getteth up to the gutter, and smiteth the Jebusites, and the lame and the blind, that are hated of David's soul <05315>, he shall be chief and captain. Wherefore they said, The blind and the lame shall not come into the house.
- 2 Samuel II:II And Uriah said unto David, The ark, and Israel, and Judah, abide in tents; and my lord Joab, and the servants of my lord, are encamped in the open fields; shall I then go into mine house, to eat and to drink, and to lie with my wife? as thou livest, and as thy soul <05315> liveth, I will not do this thing.
- 2 Samuel 14:7 And, behold, the whole family is risen against thine handmaid, and they said, Deliver him that smote his brother, that we may kill him, for the life <05315> of his brother whom he slew; and we will destroy the heir also: and so they shall quench my coal which is left, and shall not leave to my husband *neither* name nor remainder upon the earth.
- 2 Samuel 14:14 For we must needs die, and are as water spilt on the ground, which cannot be gathered up again; neither doth God respect any person <05315>: yet doth he devise means, that his banished be not expelled from him.
- 2 Samuel 14:19 And the king said, *Is not* the hand of Joab with thee in all this? And the woman answered and said, *As* thy soul <05315> liveth, my lord the king, none can turn to the right hand or to the left from ought that my lord the king hath spoken: for thy servant Joab, he bade me, and he put all these words in the mouth of thine handmaid:
- 2 Samuel 16:11 And David said to Abishai, and to all his servants, Behold, my son, which came forth of my bowels, seeketh my life <05315>: how much more now *may this* Benjamite *do it*? let him alone, and let him curse; for the LORD hath bidden him.
- 2 Samuel 17:8 For, said Hushai, thou knowest thy father and his men, that they be mighty men, and they be chafed in their minds <05315>, as a bear robbed of her whelps in the field: and thy father is a man of war, and will not lodge with the people.
- 2 Samuel 18:13 Otherwise I should have wrought falsehood against mine own life <05315>: for there is no matter hid from the king, and thou thyself wouldest have set thyself against me.
- 2 Samuel 19:5 And Joab came into the house to the king, and said, Thou hast shamed this day the faces of all thy servants, which this day have saved thy life <05315>, and the lives <05315> of thy sons and of thy daughters, and the lives <05315> of thy wives, and the lives <05315> of thy concubines;

- 2 Samuel 23:17 And he said, Be it far from me, O LORD, that I should do this: is not this the blood of the men that went in jeopardy of their lives <05315>? therefore he would not drink it. These things did these three mighty men.
- I Kings 1:12 Now therefore come, let me, I pray thee, give thee counsel, that thou mayest save thine own life <05315>, and the life <05315> of thy son Solomon.
- I Kings 1:29 And the king sware, and said, As the LORD liveth, that hath redeemed my soul <05315> out of all distress,
- I Kings 2:4 That the LORD may continue his word which he spake concerning me, saying, If thy children take heed to their way, to walk before me in truth with all their heart and with all their soul <05315>, there shall not fail thee (said he) a man on the throne of Israel.
- I Kings 2:23 Then king Solomon sware by the LORD, saying, God do so to me, and more also, if Adonijah have not spoken this word against his own life <05315>.
- I Kings 3:11 And God said unto him, Because thou hast asked this thing, and hast not asked for thyself long life; neither hast asked riches for thyself, nor hast asked the life <05315> of thine enemies; but hast asked for thyself understanding to discern judgment;
- I Kings 8:48 And so return unto thee with all their heart, and with all their soul <05315>, in the land of their enemies, which led them away captive, and pray unto thee toward their land, which thou gavest unto their fathers, the city which thou hast chosen, and the house which I have built for thy name:
- I Kings II:37 And I will take thee, and thou shalt reign according to all that thy soul <05315> desireth, and shalt be king over Israel.
- I Kings 17:21 And he stretched himself upon the child three times, and cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, I pray thee, let this child's soul <05315> come into him again.
- I Kings 17:22 And the LORD heard the voice of Elijah; and the soul <05315> of the child came into him again, and he revived.
- I Kings 19:2 Then Jezebel sent a messenger unto Elijah, saying, So let the gods do to me, and more also, if I make not thy life <05315> as the life <05315> of one of them by to morrow about this time.
- I Kings 19:3 And when he saw *that*, he arose, and went for his life <05315>, and came to Beersheba, which *belongeth* to Judah, and left his servant there.

- I Kings 19:4 But he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness, and came and sat down under a juniper tree: and he requested for himself <05315> that he might die; and said, It is enough; now, O LORD, take away my life <05315>; for I am not better than my fathers.
- I Kings 19:10 And he said, I have been very jealous for the LORD God of hosts: for the children of Israel have forsaken thy covenant, thrown down thine altars, and slain thy prophets with the sword; and I, even I only, am left; and they seek my life <05315>, to take it away.
- I Kings 19:14 And he said, I have been very jealous for the LORD God of hosts: because the children of Israel have forsaken thy covenant, thrown down thine altars, and slain thy prophets with the sword; and I, even I only, am left; and they seek my life <05315>, to take it away.
- I Kings 20:31 And his servants said unto him, Behold now, we have heard that the kings of the house of Israel *are* merciful kings: let us, I pray thee, put sackcloth on our loins, and ropes upon our heads, and go out to the king of Israel: peradventure he will save thy life <05315>.
- I Kings 20:32 So they girded sackcloth on their loins, and *put* ropes on their heads, and came to the king of Israel, and said, Thy servant Benhadad saith, I pray thee, let me live <05315>. And he said, Is he yet alive? he is my brother.
- I Kings 20:39 And as the king passed by, he cried unto the king: and he said, Thy servant went out into the midst of the battle; and, behold, a man turned aside, and brought a man unto me, and said, Keep this man: if by any means he be missing, then shall thy life <05315> be for his life <05315>, or else thou shalt pay a talent of silver.
- I Kings 20:42 And he said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Because thou hast let go out of *thy* hand a man whom I appointed to utter destruction, therefore thy life $\leq 0.05315 >$ shall go for his life $\leq 0.05315 >$, and thy people for his people.
- 2 Kings 1:13 And he sent again a captain of the third fifty with his fifty. And the third captain of fifty went up, and came and fell on his knees before Elijah, and besought him, and said unto him, O man of God, I pray thee, let my life <05315>, and the life <05315> of these fifty thy servants, be precious in thy sight.

- 2 Kings 4:27 And when she came to the man of God to the hill, she caught him by the feet: but Gehazi came near to thrust her away. And the man of God said, Let her alone; for her soul <05315> is vexed within her: and the LORD hath hid it from me, and hath not told me.
- 2 Kings 4:30 And the mother of the child said, As the LORD liveth, and as thy soul <05315> liveth, I will not leave thee. And he arose, and followed her.
- 2 Kings 7:7 Wherefore they arose and fled in the twilight, and left their tents, and their horses, and their asses, even the camp as it was, and fled for their life <05315>.
- 2 Kings 9:15 But king Joram was returned to be healed in Jezreel of the wounds which the Syrians had given him, when he fought with Hazael king of Syria.) And Jehu said, If it be your minds <05315>, then let none go forth nor escape out of the city to go to tell it in Jezreel.
- 2 Kings 10:24 And when they went in to offer sacrifices and burnt offerings, Jehu appointed fourscore men without, and said, *If* any of the men whom I have brought into your hands escape, *he that letteth him go*, his life <05315> shall be for the life <05315> of him.
- 2 Kings 12:4 And Jehoash said to the priests, All the money of the dedicated things that is brought into the house of the LORD, even the money of every one that passeth the account, the money that every man <05315> is set at, and all the money that cometh into any man's heart to bring into the house of the LORD,
- 2 Kings 23:3 And the king stood by a pillar, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all *their* heart and all *their* soul <05315>, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. - 2 Chronicles 15:12 And they entered into a covenant to seek the LORD God of their fathers with all their heart and with all their soul <05315>;
- 2 Chronicles 34:31 And the king stood in his place, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments, and his testimonies, and his statutes, with all his heart, and with all his soul <05315>, to perform the words of the covenant which are written in this book.

- Esther 4:13 Then Mordecai commanded to answer Esther, Think not with thyself <05315> that thou shalt escape in the king's house, more than all the Jews.
- Esther 7:3 Then Esther the queen answered and said, If I have found favour in thy sight, O king, and if it please the king, let my life <05315> be given me at my petition, and my people at my request:
- Esther 7:7 And the king arising from the banquet of wine in his wrath went into the palace garden: and Haman stood up to make request for his life <05315> to Esther the queen; for he saw that there was evil determined against him by the king.

- Psalms 121:7 The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul <05315>.
- Psalms 123:4 Our soul <05315> is exceedingly filled with the scorning of those that are at ease, and with the contempt of the proud.
- Psalms 124:4 Then the waters had overwhelmed us, the stream had gone over our soul <05315>:
- Psalms 124:5 Then the proud waters had gone over our soul <05315>.
- Psalms 124:7 Our soul <05315> is escaped as a bird out of the snare of the fowlers: the snare is broken, and we are escaped.
- Psalms 130:5 I wait for the LORD, my soul <05315> doth wait, and in his word do I hope.
- Psalms 130:6 My soul <05315> waiteth for the Lord more than they that watch for the morning: I say, more than they that watch for the morning.

- Psalms 131:2 Surely I have behaved and quieted myself <05315>, as a child that is weaned of his mother: my soul <05315> is even as a weaned child.
- Psalms 138:3 In the day when I cried thou answeredst me, and strengthenedst me with strength in my soul <05315>.

- Psalms 143:12 And of thy mercy cut off mine enemies, and destroy all them that afflict my soul <05315>: for I am thy servant.
- Psalms 146:1 Praise ye the LORD. Praise the LORD, O my soul <a href="mailto: <a href="mailto:. Proverbs 1:18 And they lay wait for their own blood; they lurk privily for their own lives <a href="mailto: <
- Proverbs 1:19 So are the ways of every one that is greedy of gain; which taketh away the life <05315> of the owners thereof.
- Proverbs 2:10 When wisdom entereth into thine heart, and knowledge is pleasant unto thy soul <05315>;
- Proverbs 3:22 So shall they be life unto thy soul <05315>, and grace to thy neck.
- Proverbs 6:16 These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him <05315>:
- Proverbs 6:26 For by means of a whorish woman a man is brought to a piece of bread: and the adulteress will hunt for the precious life <05315>.

- Proverbs 6:30 Men do not despise a thief, if he steal to satisfy his soul <05315> when he is hungry;
- Proverbs 6:32 But whoso committeth adultery with a woman lacketh understanding: he that doeth it destroyeth his own soul <05315>.
- Proverbs 7:23 Till a dart strike through his liver; as a bird hasteth to the snare, and knoweth not that it is for his life <05315>.
- Proverbs 8:36 But he that sinneth against me wrongeth his own soul <05315>: all they that hate me love death.
- Proverbs 10:3 The LORD will not suffer the soul <05315> of the righteous to famish: but he casteth away the substance of the wicked.
- Proverbs 11:17 The merciful man doeth good to his own soul <05315>: but he that is cruel troubleth his own flesh.

- Proverbs 15:32 He that refuseth instruction despiseth his own soul <05315>: but he that heareth reproof getteth understanding.
- Proverbs 16:17 The highway of the upright is to depart from evil: he that keepeth his way preserveth his soul <05315>.

- Proverbs 16:24 Pleasant words are as an honeycomb, sweet to the soul <05315>, and health to the bones.
- Proverbs 16:26 He <05315> that laboureth laboureth for himself; for his mouth craveth it of him.
- Proverbs 18:7 A fool's mouth is his destruction, and his lips are the snare of his soul <05315>.
- Proverbs 19:2 Also, that the soul <05315> be without knowledge, it is not good; and he that hasteth with his feet sinneth.
- Proverbs 19:8 He that getteth wisdom loveth his own soul <05315>: he that keepeth understanding shall find good.
- Proverbs 19:15 Slothfulness casteth into a deep sleep; and an idle soul <05315> shall suffer hunger.
- Proverbs 19:16 He that keepeth the commandment keepeth his own soul <05315>; but he that despiseth his ways shall die.
- Proverbs 19:18 Chasten thy son while there is hope, and let not thy soul <05315> spare for his crying.
- Proverbs 20:2 The fear of a king is as the roaring of a lion: whoso provoketh him to anger sinneth against his own soul <05315>.
- Proverbs 21:10 The soul <05315> of the wicked desireth evil: his neighbour findeth no favour in his eyes.
- Proverbs 21:23 Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul <05315> from troubles.
- Proverbs 22:5 Thorns and snares are in the way of the froward: he that doth keep his soul <05315> shall be far from them.
- Proverbs 22:23 For the LORD will plead their cause, and spoil the soul <05315> of those that spoiled them.
- Proverbs 22:25 Lest thou learn his ways, and get a snare to thy soul <05315>.
- Proverbs 23:2 And put a knife to thy throat, if thou be a man given to appetite <05315>.
- Proverbs 23:7 For as he thinketh in his heart <05315>, so is he: Eat and drink, saith he to thee; but his heart is not with thee.

- Proverbs 24:14 So shall the knowledge of wisdom be unto thy soul <05315>: when thou hast found it, then there shall be a reward, and thy expectation shall not be cut off.
- Proverbs 25:13 As the cold of snow in the time of harvest, so is a faithful messenger to them that send him: for he refresheth the soul <05315> of his masters.
- Proverbs 25:25 As cold waters to a thirsty soul <05315>, so is good news from a far country.
- Proverbs 27:7 The full soul <05315> loatheth an honeycomb; but to the hungry soul <05315> every bitter thing is sweet.
- Proverbs 27:9 Ointment and perfume rejoice the heart: so doth the sweetness of a man's friend by hearty <05315> counsel.
- Proverbs 28:17 A man that doeth violence to the blood of any person <05315> shall flee to the pit; let no man stay him.
- Proverbs 28:25 He that is of a proud heart <05315> stirreth up strife: but he that putteth his trust in the LORD shall be made fat.
- Proverbs 29:10 The bloodthirsty hate the upright: but the just seek his soul <05315>.
- Proverbs 29:17 Correct thy son, and he shall give thee rest; yea, he shall give delight unto thy soul <05315>.
- Proverbs 29:24 Whoso is partner with a thief hateth his own soul <05315>: he heareth cursing, and bewrayeth it not.
- Proverbs 31:6 Give strong drink unto him that is ready to perish, and wine unto those that be of heavy hearts <05315>.
- Ecclesiastes 2:24 There is nothing better for a man, than that he should eat and drink, and that he should make his soul <05315> enjoy good in his labour. This also I saw, that it was from the hand of God.
- Ecclesiastes 4:8 There is one alone, and there is not a second; yea, he hath neither child nor brother: yet is there no end of all his labour; neither is his eye satisfied with riches; neither saith he, For whom do I labour, and bereave my soul <05315> of good? This is also vanity, yea, it is a sore travail.
- Ecclesiastes 6:2 A man to whom God hath given riches, wealth, and honour, so that he wanteth nothing for his soul <05315> of all that he desireth, yet God giveth him not power to eat thereof, but a stranger eateth it: this is vanity, and it is an evil disease.

- Ecclesiastes 6:3 If a man beget an hundred children, and live many years, so that the days of his years be many, and his soul <05315> be not filled with good, and also that he have no burial; I say, that an untimely birth is better than he.
- Ecclesiastes 6:7 All the labour of man is for his mouth, and yet the appetite <05315> is not filled.
- Ecclesiastes 6:9 Better is the sight of the eyes than the wandering of the desire <05315>: this is also vanity and vexation of spirit.
- Ecclesiastes 7:28 Which yet my soul <05315> seeketh, but I find not: one man among a thousand have I found; but a woman among all those have I not found.
- Song of Solomon 1:7 Tell me, O thou whom my soul <05315> loveth, where thou feedest, where thou makest thy flock to rest at noon: for why should I be as one that turneth aside by the flocks of thy companions?
- Song of Solomon 3:1 By night on my bed I sought him whom my soul <05315> loveth: I sought him, but I found him not.
- Song of Solomon 3:2 I will rise now, and go about the city in the streets, and in the broad ways I will seek him whom my soul <05315> loveth: I sought him, but I found him not.
- Song of Solomon 3:3 The watchmen that go about the city found me: to whom I said, Saw ye him whom my soul <05315> loveth?
- Song of Solomon 3:4 It was but a little that I passed from them, but I found him whom my soul <05315> loveth: I held him, and would not let him go, until I had brought him into my mother's house, and into the chamber of her that conceived me.
- Song of Solomon 5:6 I opened to my beloved; but my beloved had withdrawn himself, and was gone: my soul <05315> failed when he spake: I sought him, but I could not find him; I called him, but he gave me no answer.
- Song of Solomon 6:12 Or ever I was aware, my soul <05315> made me like the chariots of Amminadib.

The Scriptures - Prophets

- Isaiah 1:14 Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul <05315> hateth: they are a trouble unto me; I am weary to bear them.
- Isaiah 3:9 The shew of their countenance doth witness against them; and they declare their sin as Sodom, they hide *it* not. Woe unto their soul <05315>! for they have rewarded evil unto themselves.
- Isaiah 3:20 The bonnets, and the ornaments of the legs, and the headbands, and the tablets <0.5315>, and the earrings,
- Isaiah 5:14 Therefore hell hath enlarged herself <05315>, and opened her mouth without measure: and their glory, and their multitude, and their pomp, and he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it.
- Isaiah 10:18 And shall consume the glory of his forest, and of his fruitful field, both soul <05315> and body: and they shall be as when a standardbearer fainteth.
- Isaiah 15:4 And Heshbon shall cry, and Elealeh: their voice shall be heard even unto Jahaz: therefore the armed soldiers of Moab shall cry out; his life <05315> shall be grievous unto him.
- Isaiah 19:10 And they shall be broken in the purposes thereof, all that make sluices *and* ponds for fish <05315>.
- Isaiah 26:8 Yea, in the way of thy judgments, O LORD, have we waited for thee; the desire of *our* soul <05315> is to thy name, and to the remembrance of thee.
- Isaiah 26:9 With my soul <05315> have I desired thee in the night; yea, with my spirit within me will I seek thee early: for when thy judgments are in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness.
- Isaiah 29:8 It shall even be as when an hungry *man* dreameth, and, behold, he eateth; but he awaketh, and his soul <05315> is empty: or as when a thirsty man dreameth, and, behold, he drinketh; but he awaketh, and, behold, he is faint, and his soul <05315> hath appetite: so shall the multitude of all the nations be, that fight against mount Zion.
- Isaiah 32:6 For the vile person will speak villany, and his heart will work iniquity, to practise hypocrisy, and to utter error against the LORD, to make empty the soul <05315> of the hungry, and he will cause the drink of the thirsty to fail.

- Isaiah 38:15 What shall I say? he hath both spoken unto me, and himself hath done it: I shall go softly all my years in the bitterness of my soul <05315>.
- Isaiah 38:17 Behold, for peace I had great bitterness: but thou hast in love to my soul <05315> delivered it from the pit of corruption: for thou hast cast all my sins behind thy back.
- Isaiah 42:1 Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, *in whom* my soul <05315> delighteth; I have put my spirit upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles.
- Isaiah 43:4 Since thou wast precious in my sight, thou hast been honourable, and I have loved thee: therefore will I give men for thee, and people for thy life <05315>.
- Isaiah 44:20 He feedeth on ashes: a deceived heart hath turned him aside, that he cannot deliver his soul <05315>, nor say, *Is there* not a lie in my right hand?
- Isaiah 46:2 They stoop, they bow down together; they could not deliver the burden, but themselves <05315> are gone into captivity.
- Isaiah 47:14 Behold, they shall be as stubble; the fire shall burn them; they shall not deliver themselves <05315> from the power of the flame: there shall not be a coal to warm at, nor fire to sit before it.
- Isaiah 49:7 Thus saith the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, and his Holy One, to him whom man <05315> despiseth, to him whom the nation abhorreth, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the LORD that is faithful, and the Holy One of Israel, and he shall choose thee.
- Isaiah 51:23 But I will put it into the hand of them that afflict thee; which have said to thy soul $\leq 0.05315 >$, Bow down, that we may go over: and thou hast laid thy body as the ground, and as the street, to them that went over.
- Isaiah 53:10 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul <05315> an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.
- Isaiah 53:11 He shall see of the travail of his soul <05315>, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.
- Isaiah 53:12 Therefore will I divide him *a portion* with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul <05315> unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

- Isaiah 55:2 Wherefore do ye spend money for *that which is* not bread? and your labour for *that which* satisfieth not? hearken diligently unto me, and eat ye *that which* is good, and let your soul <05315> delight itself in fatness.
- Isaiah 55:3 Incline your ear, and come unto me: hear, and your soul <05315> shall live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, even the sure mercies of David.
- Isaiah 56:11 Yea, they are greedy <05315> dogs which can never have enough, and they are shepherds that cannot understand: they all look to their own way, every one for his gain, from his quarter.
- Isaiah 58:3 Wherefore have we fasted, say they, and thou seest not? wherefore have we afflicted our soul <05315>, and thou takest no knowledge? Behold, in the day of your fast ye find pleasure, and exact all your labours.
- Isaiah 58:5 Is it such a fast that I have chosen? a day for a man to afflict his soul <05315>? is it to bow down his head as a bulrush, and to spread sackcloth and ashes under him? wilt thou call this a fast, and an acceptable day to the LORD?
- Isaiah 58:10 And if thou draw out thy soul $\leq 0.05315 \geq$ to the hungry, and satisfy the afflicted soul $\leq 0.05315 \geq$; then shall thy light rise in obscurity, and thy darkness be as the noonday:
- Isaiah 58:11 And the LORD shall guide thee continually, and satisfy thy soul <05315> in drought, and make fat thy bones: and thou shalt be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters fail not.
- Isaiah 61:10 I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul <05315> shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth herself with her jewels.
- Isaiah 66:3 He that killeth an ox is as if he slew a man; he that sacrificeth a lamb, as if he cut off a dog's neck; he that offereth an oblation, as if he offered swine's blood; he that burneth incense, as if he blessed an idol. Yea, they have chosen their own ways, and their soul <05315> delighteth in their abominations.
- Jeremiah 2:24 A wild ass used to the wilderness, *that* snuffeth up the wind at her pleasure <05315>; in her occasion who can turn her away? all they that seek her will not weary themselves; in her month they shall find her.
- Jeremiah 2:34 Also in thy skirts is found the blood of the souls <05315> of the poor innocents: I have not found it by secret search, but upon all these.
- Jeremiah 3:11 And the LORD said unto me, The backsliding Israel hath justified herself <05315> more than treacherous Judah.

- Jeremiah 4:10 Then said I, Ah, Lord GOD! surely thou hast greatly deceived this people and Jerusalem, saying, Ye shall have peace; whereas the sword reacheth unto the soul <05315>.
- Jeremiah 4:19 My bowels, my bowels! I am pained at my very heart; my heart maketh a noise in me; I cannot hold my peace, because thou hast heard, O my soul <05315>, the sound of the trumpet, the alarm of war.
- Jeremiah 4:30 And when thou art spoiled, what wilt thou do? Though thou clothest thyself with crimson, though thou deckest thee with ornaments of gold, though thou rentest thy face with painting, in vain shalt thou make thyself fair; thy lovers will despise thee, they will seek thy life <05315>.
- Jeremiah 4:31 For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, and the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, that bewaileth herself, that spreadeth her hands, saying, Woe is me now! for my soul <05315> is wearied because of murderers.
- Jeremiah 5:9 Shall I not visit for these *things*? saith the LORD: and shall not my soul <0.05315> be avenged on such a nation as this?
- Jeremiah 5:29 Shall I not visit for these *things*? saith the LORD: shall not my soul <05315> be avenged on such a nation as this?
- Jeremiah 6:8 Be thou instructed, O Jerusalem, lest my soul <05315> depart from thee; lest I make thee desolate, a land not inhabited.
- Jeremiah 6:16 Thus saith the LORD, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls <05315>. But they said, We will not walk therein.
- Jeremiah 9:9 Shall I not visit them for these *things*? saith the LORD: shall not my soul <05315> be avenged on such a nation as this?
- Jeremiah 11:21 Therefore thus saith the LORD of the men of Anathoth, that seek thy life <05315>, saying, Prophesy not in the name of the LORD, that thou die not by our hand:
- Jeremiah 12:7 I have forsaken mine house, I have left mine heritage; I have given the dearly beloved of my soul <05315> into the hand of her enemies.
- Jeremiah 13:17 But if ye will not hear it, my soul <05315> shall weep in secret places for *your* pride; and mine eye shall weep sore, and run down with tears, because the LORD'S flock is carried away captive.
- Jeremiah 14:19 Hast thou utterly rejected Judah? hath thy soul <05315> lothed Zion? why hast thou smitten us, and there is no healing for us? we looked for peace, and there is no good; and for the time of healing, and behold trouble!

- Jeremiah 15:1 Then said the LORD unto me, Though Moses and Samuel stood before me, yet my mind <05315> could not be toward this people: cast them out of my sight, and let them go forth.
- Jeremiah 15:9 She that hath borne seven languisheth: she hath given up the ghost <05315>; her sun is gone down while it was yet day: she hath been ashamed and confounded: and the residue of them will I deliver to the sword before their enemies, saith the LORD.
- Jeremiah 17:21 Thus saith the LORD; Take heed to yourselves <05315>, and bear no burden on the sabbath day, nor bring it in by the gates of Jerusalem;
- Jeremiah 18:20 Shall evil be recompensed for good? for they have digged a pit for my soul <05315>. Remember that I stood before thee to speak good for them, and to turn away thy wrath from them.
- Jeremiah 19:7 And I will make void the counsel of Judah and Jerusalem in this place; and I will cause them to fall by the sword before their enemies, and by the hands of them that seek their lives <05315>: and their carcases will I give to be meat for the fowls of the heaven, and for the beasts of the earth.
- Jeremiah 19:9 And I will cause them to eat the flesh of their sons and the flesh of their daughters, and they shall eat every one the flesh of his friend in the siege and straitness, wherewith their enemies, and they that seek their lives <05315>, shall straiten them.
- Jeremiah 20:13 Sing unto the LORD, praise ye the LORD: for he hath delivered the soul <05315> of the poor from the hand of evildoers.
- Jeremiah 21:7 And afterward, saith the LORD, I will deliver Zedekiah king of Judah, and his servants, and the people, and such as are left in this city from the pestilence, from the sword, and from the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of those that seek their life <05315>: and he shall smite them with the edge of the sword; he shall not spare them, neither have pity, nor have mercy.
- Jeremiah 21:9 He that abideth in this city shall die by the sword, and by the famine, and by the pestilence: but he that goeth out, and falleth to the Chaldeans that besiege you, he shall live, and his life <05315> shall be unto him for a prey.
- Jeremiah 22:25 And I will give thee into the hand of them that seek thy life <05315>, and into the hand of them whose face thou fearest, even into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of the Chaldeans.
- Jeremiah 22:27 But to the land whereunto they desire <05315> to return, thither shall they not return.

- Jeremiah 26:19 Did Hezekiah king of Judah and all Judah put him at all to death? did he not fear the LORD, and besought the LORD, and the LORD repented him of the evil which he had pronounced against them? Thus might we procure great evil against our souls <05315>.
- Jeremiah 31:12 Therefore they shall come and sing in the height of Zion, and shall flow together to the goodness of the LORD, for wheat, and for wine, and for oil, and for the young of the flock and of the herd: and their soul <05315> shall be as a watered garden; and they shall not sorrow any more at all.
- Jeremiah 31:14 And I will satiate the soul <05315> of the priests with fatness, and my people shall be satisfied with my goodness, saith the LORD.
- Jeremiah 31:25 For I have satiated the weary soul <05315>, and I have replenished every sorrowful soul <05315>.
- Jeremiah 32:41 Yea, I will rejoice over them to do them good, and I will plant them in this land assuredly with my whole heart and with my whole soul <05315>.
- Jeremiah 34:16 But ye turned and polluted my name, and caused every man his servant, and every man his handmaid, whom ye had set at liberty at their pleasure <05315>, to return, and brought them into subjection, to be unto you for servants and for handmaids.
- Jeremiah 34:20 I will even give them into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of them that seek their life <05315>: and their dead bodies shall be for meat unto the fowls of the heaven, and to the beasts of the earth.
- Jeremiah 34:21 And Zedekiah king of Judah and his princes will I give into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of them that seek their life <05315>, and into the hand of the king of Babylon's army, which are gone up from you.
- Jeremiah 37:9 Thus saith the LORD; Deceive not yourselves <05315>, saying, The Chaldeans shall surely depart from us: for they shall not depart.
- Jeremiah 38:2 Thus saith the LORD, He that remaineth in this city shall die by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence: but he that goeth forth to the Chaldeans shall live; for he shall have his life <05315> for a prey, and shall live.
- Jeremiah 38:16 So Zedekiah the king sware secretly unto Jeremiah, saying, As the LORD liveth, that made us this soul <05315>, I will not put thee to death, neither will I give thee into the hand of these men that seek thy life <05315>.

- Jeremiah 38:17 Then said Jeremiah unto Zedekiah, Thus saith the LORD, the God of hosts, the God of Israel; If thou wilt assuredly go forth unto the king of Babylon's princes, then thy soul <05315> shall live, and this city shall not be burned with fire; and thou shalt live, and thine house:
- Jeremiah 38:20 But Jeremiah said, They shall not deliver *thee*. Obey, I beseech thee, the voice of the LORD, which I speak unto thee: so it shall be well unto thee, and thy soul <05315> shall live.
- Jeremiah 39:18 For I will surely deliver thee, and thou shalt not fall by the sword, but thy life <05315> shall be for a prey unto thee: because thou hast put thy trust in me, saith the LORD.
- Jeremiah 40:14 And said unto him, Dost thou certainly know that Baalis the king of the Ammonites hath sent Ishmael the son of Nethaniah to slay <05315> thee? But Gedaliah the son of Ahikam believed them not.
- Jeremiah 40:15 Then Johanan the son of Kareah spake to Gedaliah in Mizpah secretly, saying, Let me go, I pray thee, and I will slay Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and no man shall know it: wherefore should he slay <05315> thee, that all the Jews which are gathered unto thee should be scattered, and the remnant in Judah perish?
- Jeremiah 42:20 For ye dissembled in your hearts <color: blue;, when ye sent me unto the LORD your God, saying, Pray for us unto the LORD our God; and according unto all that the LORD our God shall say, so declare unto us, and we will do it.
- Jeremiah 43:6 Even men, and women, and children, and the king's daughters, and every person <05315> that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had left with Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Jeremiah the prophet, and Baruch the son of Neriah.
- Jeremiah 44:7 Therefore now thus saith the LORD, the God of hosts, the God of Israel; Wherefore commit ye *this* great evil against your souls <05315>, to cut off from you man and woman, child and suckling, out of Judah, to leave you none to remain;
- Jeremiah 44:14 So that none of the remnant of Judah, which are gone into the land of Egypt to sojourn there, shall escape or remain, that they should return into the land of Judah, to the which they have a desire <05315> to return to dwell there: for none shall return but such as shall escape.
- Jeremiah 44:30 Thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will give Pharaohhophra king of Egypt into the hand of his enemies, and into the hand of them that seek his life <05315>; as I gave Zedekiah king of Judah into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, his enemy, and that sought his life <05315>.

- Jeremiah 45:5 And seekest thou great things for thyself? seek *them* not: for, behold, I will bring evil upon all flesh, saith the LORD: but thy life <05315> will I give unto thee for a prey in all places whither thou goest.
- Jeremiah 46:26 And I will deliver them into the hand of those that seek their lives <05315>, and into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of his servants: and afterward it shall be inhabited, as in the days of old, saith the LORD.
- Jeremiah 48:6 Flee, save your lives <05315>, and be like the heath in the wilderness.
- Jeremiah 49:37 For I will cause Elam to be dismayed before their enemies, and before them that seek their life <05315>: and I will bring evil upon them, even my fierce anger, saith the LORD; and I will send the sword after them, till I have consumed them:
- Jeremiah 50:19 And I will bring Israel again to his habitation, and he shall feed on Carmel and Bashan, and his soul <05315> shall be satisfied upon mount Ephraim and Gilead.
- Jeremiah 51:6 Flee out of the midst of Babylon, and deliver every man his soul <05315>: be not cut off in her iniquity; for this is the time of the LORD'S vengeance; he will render unto her a recompence.
- Jeremiah 51:14 The LORD of hosts hath sworn by himself <05315>, saying, Surely I will fill thee with men, as with caterpillers; and they shall lift up a shout against thee.
- Jeremiah 51:45 My people, go ye out of the midst of her, and deliver ye every man his soul <05315> from the fierce anger of the LORD.
- Jeremiah 52:29 In the eighteenth year of Nebuchadrezzar he carried away captive from Jerusalem eight hundred thirty and two persons <05315>:
- Jeremiah 52:30 In the three and twentieth year of Nebuchadrezzar Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive of the Jews seven hundred forty and five persons <05315>: all the persons <05315> were four thousand and six hundred.
- Lamentations 1:11 All her people sigh, they seek bread; they have given their pleasant things for meat to relieve the soul <05315>: see, O LORD, and consider; for I am become vile.
- Lamentations 1:16 For these *things* I weep; mine eye, mine eye runneth down with water, because the comforter that should relieve my soul <05315> is far from me: my children are desolate, because the enemy prevailed.
- Lamentations 1:19 I called for my lovers, but they deceived me: my priests and mine elders gave up the ghost in the city, while they sought their meat to relieve their souls <05315>.

- Lamentations 2:12 They say to their mothers, Where is corn and wine? when they swooned as the wounded in the streets of the city, when their soul <05315> was poured out into their mothers' bosom.
- Lamentations 2:19 Arise, cry out in the night: in the beginning of the watches pour out thine heart like water before the face of the Lord: lift up thy hands toward him for the life <05315> of thy young children, that faint for hunger in the top of every street.
- Lamentations 3:17 And thou hast removed my soul <05315> far off from peace: I forgat prosperity.
- Lamentations 3:20 My soul <05315> hath them still in remembrance, and is humbled in me.
- Lamentations 3:24 The LORD is my portion, saith my soul <05315>; therefore will I hope in him.
- Lamentations 3:25 The LORD is good unto them that wait for him, to the soul <05315> that seeketh him.
- Lamentations 3:51 Mine eye affecteth mine heart <05315> because of all the daughters of my city.
- Lamentations 3:58 O Lord, thou hast pleaded the causes of my soul <05315>; thou hast redeemed my life.
- Lamentations 5:9 We gat our bread with the peril of our lives <05315> because of the sword of the wilderness.
- Ezekiel 3:19 Yet if thou warn the wicked, and he turn not from his wickedness, nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but thou hast delivered thy soul <05315>.
- Ezekiel 3:21 Nevertheless if thou warn the righteous *man*, that the righteous sin not, and he doth not sin, he shall surely live, because he is warned; also thou hast delivered thy soul <05315>.
- Ezekiel 4:14 Then said I, Ah Lord GOD! behold, my soul <05315> hath not been polluted: for from my youth up even till now have I not eaten of that which dieth of itself, or is torn in pieces; neither came there abominable flesh into my mouth.
- Ezekiel 7:19 They shall cast their silver in the streets, and their gold shall be removed: their silver and their gold shall not be able to deliver them in the day of the wrath of the LORD: they shall not satisfy their souls <05315>, neither fill their bowels: because it is the stumblingblock of their iniquity.
- Ezekiel 13:18 And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Woe to the *women* that sew pillows to all armholes, and make kerchiefs upon the head of every stature to hunt souls <05315>! Will ye hunt the souls <05315> of my people, and will ye save the souls <05315> alive *that come* unto you?

- Ezekiel 13:19 And will ye pollute me among my people for handfuls of barley and for pieces of bread, to slay the souls <05315> that should not die, and to save the souls <05315> alive that should not live, by your lying to my people that hear your lies?
- Ezekiel 13:20 Wherefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against your pillows, wherewith ye there hunt the souls <05315> to make them fly, and I will tear them from your arms, and will let the souls <05315> go, even the souls <05315> that ye hunt to make them fly.
- Ezekiel 14:14 Though these three men, Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, they should deliver *but* their own souls <05315> by their righteousness, saith the Lord GOD.
- Ezekiel 14:20 Though Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, as I live, saith the Lord GOD, they shall deliver neither son nor daughter; they shall but deliver their own souls <05315> by their righteousness.
- Ezekiel 16:5 None eye pitied thee, to do any of these unto thee, to have compassion upon thee; but thou wast cast out in the open field, to the lothing of thy person <05315>, in the day that thou wast born.
- Ezekiel 16:27 Behold, therefore I have stretched out my hand over thee, and have diminished thine ordinary *food*, and delivered thee unto the will <05315> of them that hate thee, the daughters of the Philistines, which are ashamed of thy lewd way.
- Ezekiel 17:17 Neither shall Pharaoh with *his* mighty army and great company make for him in the war, by casting up mounts, and building forts, to cut off many persons <05315>:
- Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls <05315> are mine; as the soul <05315> of the father, so also the soul <05315> of the son is mine: the soul <05315> that sinneth, it shall die.
- Ezekiel 18:20 The soul <05315> that sinneth, it shall die. The son shall not bear the iniquity of the father, neither shall the father bear the iniquity of the son: the righteousness of the righteous shall be upon him, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon him.
- Ezekiel 18:27 Again, when the wicked *man* turneth away from his wickedness that he hath committed, and doeth that which is lawful and right, he shall save his soul <05315> alive.
- Ezekiel 22:25 There is a conspiracy of her prophets in the midst thereof, like a roaring lion ravening the prey; they have devoured souls <05315>; they have taken the treasure and precious things; they have made her many widows in the midst thereof.

- Ezekiel 22:27 Her princes in the midst thereof *are* like wolves ravening the prey, to shed blood, *and* to destroy souls <05315>, to get dishonest gain.
- Ezekiel 23:17 And the Babylonians came to her into the bed of love, and they defiled her with their whoredom, and she was polluted with them, and her mind <05315> was alienated from them.
- Ezekiel 23:18 So she discovered her whoredoms, and discovered her nakedness: then my mind <05315> was alienated from her, like as my mind <05315> was alienated from her sister.
- Ezekiel 23:22 Therefore, O Aholibah, thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will raise up thy lovers against thee, from whom thy mind <05315> is alienated, and I will bring them against thee on every side;
- Ezekiel 23:28 For thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will deliver thee into the hand of them whom thou hatest, into the hand of them from whom thy mind <05315> is alienated:
- Ezekiel 24:21 Speak unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will profane my sanctuary, the excellency of your strength, the desire of your eyes, and that which your soul <05315> pitieth; and your sons and your daughters whom ye have left shall fall by the sword.
- Ezekiel 24:25 Also, thou son of man, shall it not be in the day when I take from them their strength, the joy of their glory, the desire of their eyes, and that whereupon they set their minds <05315>, their sons and their daughters,
- Ezekiel 25:6 For thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thou hast clapped *thine* hands, and stamped with the feet, and rejoiced in heart <05315> with all thy despite against the land of Israel;
- Ezekiel 25:15 Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because the Philistines have dealt by revenge, and have taken vengeance with a despiteful heart <05315>, to destroy it for the old hatred;
- Ezekiel 27:13 Javan, Tubal, and Meshech, they were thy merchants: they traded the persons <05315> of men and vessels of brass in thy market.
- Ezekiel 27:31 And they shall make themselves utterly bald for thee, and gird them with sackcloth, and they shall weep for thee with bitterness of heart <05315> and bitter wailing.
- Ezekiel 32:10 Yea, I will make many people amazed at thee, and their kings shall be horribly afraid for thee, when I shall brandish my sword before them; and they shall tremble at every moment, every man for his own life <05315>, in the day of thy fall.
- Ezekiel 33:5 He heard the sound of the trumpet, and took not warning; his blood shall be upon him. But he that taketh warning shall deliver his soul <05315>.

- Ezekiel 33:6 But if the watchman see the sword come, and blow not the trumpet, and the people be not warned; if the sword come, and take *any* person <05315> from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at the watchman's hand.
- Ezekiel 33:9 Nevertheless, if thou warn the wicked of his way to turn from it; if he do not turn from his way, he shall die in his iniquity; but thou hast delivered thy soul <05315>.
- Ezekiel 36:5 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Surely in the fire of my jealousy have I spoken against the residue of the heathen, and against all Idumea, which have appointed my land into their possession with the joy of all *their* heart, with despiteful minds <05315>, to cast it out for a prey.
- Ezekiel 47:9 And it shall come to pass, *that* every thing <05315> that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers shall come, shall live: and there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither: for they shall be healed; and every thing shall live whither the river cometh.
- Hosea 4:8 They eat up the sin of my people, and they set their heart <05315> on their iniquity.
- Hosea 9:4 They shall not offer wine offerings to the LORD, neither shall they be pleasing unto him: their sacrifices shall be unto them as the bread of mourners; all that eat thereof shall be polluted: for their bread for their soul <05315> shall not come into the house of the LORD.
- Amos 2:14 Therefore the flight shall perish from the swift, and the strong shall not strengthen his force, neither shall the mighty deliver himself <05315>:
- Amos 2:15 Neither shall he stand that handleth the bow; and he that is swift of foot shall not deliver himself: neither shall he that rideth the horse deliver himself <05315>.
- Amos 6:8 The Lord GOD hath sworn by himself <05315>, saith the LORD the God of hosts, I abhor the excellency of Jacob, and hate his palaces: therefore will I deliver up the city with all that is therein.
- Jonah I:14 Wherefore they cried unto the LORD, and said, We beseech thee, O LORD, we beseech thee, let us not perish for this man's life <05315>, and lay not upon us innocent blood: for thou, O LORD, hast done as it pleased thee.
- Jonah 2:5 The waters compassed me about, even to the soul <05315>: the depth closed me round about, the weeds were wrapped about my head.
- Jonah 2:7 When my soul <05315> fainted within me I remembered the LORD: and my prayer came in unto thee, into thine holy temple.

- Jonah 4:3 Therefore now, O LORD, take, I beseech thee, my life <05315> from me; for it is better for me to die than to live.
- Jonah 4:8 And it came to pass, when the sun did arise, that God prepared a vehement east wind; and the sun beat upon the head of Jonah, that he fainted, and wished in himself $\leq 0.05315 \geq$ to die, and said, *It is* better for me to die than to live.
- Micah 6:7 Will the LORD be pleased with thousands of rams, or with ten thousands of rivers of oil? shall I give my firstborn for my transgression, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul <05315>?
- Micah 7:1 Woe is me! for I am as when they have gathered the summer fruits, as the grapegleanings of the vintage: there is no cluster to eat: my soul <05315> desired the firstripe fruit.
- Micah 7:3 That they may do evil with both hands earnestly, the prince asketh, and the judge asketh for a reward; and the great man, he uttereth his mischievous desire <05315>: so they wrap it up.
- Habakkuk 2:4 Behold, his soul <05315> which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.
- Habakkuk 2:5 Yea also, because he transgresseth by wine, he is a proud man, neither keepeth at home, who enlargeth his desire <05315> as hell, and is as death, and cannot be satisfied, but gathereth unto him all nations, and heapeth unto him all people:
- Habakkuk 2:10 Thou hast consulted shame to thy house by cutting off many people, and hast sinned *against* thy soul <05315>.
- Haggai 2:13 Then said Haggai, If one that is unclean by a dead body <05315> touch any of these, shall it be unclean? And the priests answered and said, It shall be unclean.
- Zechariah II:8 Three shepherds also I cut off in one month; and my soul <05315> lothed them, and their soul <05315> also abhorred me.

Chapter

5

The Scriptures - Gospels

The Greek word for soul is *psuche* (Pronounced *psoo-khay*' Strong's #5590 Greek: $\psi \nu \chi \eta$), from which we get our modern word Psychology (the study of the soul). The word *psuche* is translated in the King James Version the following ways:

- soul 58 (55.2% of total)
- life 40 (38.1% of total)
- mind 3

- Heart 1
- heartily + 1537 1,
- not translated 2

Dr. Strong defines Psuche as follows:

- 1) breath
 - 1a) the breath of life
 - 1a1) the vital force which animates the body and shows itself in breathing
 - 1a1a) of animals
 - 1a1b) of men
 - 1b) life
 - 1c) that in which there is life
 - 1c1) a living being, a living soul
- 2) the soul
 - 2a) the seat of the feelings, desires, affections, aversions (our heart, soul etc.)
 - 2b) the (human) soul in so far as it is constituted that by the right use of the aids offered it by God it can attain its highest end and secure eternal blessedness, the soul regarded as a moral being designed for everlasting life
 - 2c) the soul as an essence which differs from the body and is not dissolved by death (distinguished from other parts of the body)

- Matthew 2:20 Saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and go into the land of Israel: for they are dead which sought the young child's life <5590>.
- Matthew 6:25 Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life <5590>, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life <5590> more than meat, and the body than raiment?
- Matthew 10:28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul <5590>: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul <5590> and body in hell.
- Matthew 10:39 He that findeth his life $\leq 5590 \geq$ shall lose it: and he that loseth his life $\leq 5590 \geq$ for my sake shall find it.
- Matthew 11:29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls <5590>.
- Matthew 12:18 Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul <5590> is well pleased: I will put my spirit upon him, and he shall shew judgment to the Gentiles.
- Matthew 16:25 For whosoever will save his life <5590> shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life <5590> for my sake shall find it.
- Matthew 16:26 For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul <5590>? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul <5590>?
- Matthew 20:28 Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life <5590> a ransom for many.
- Matthew 22:37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul <5590>, and with all thy mind.
- Matthew 26:38 Then saith he unto them, My soul <5590> is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: tarry ye here, and watch with me.
- Mark 3:4 And he saith unto them, Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days, or to do evil? to save life <5590>, or to kill? But they held their peace.
- Mark 8:35 For whosoever will save his life <5590> shall lose it; but whosoever shall lose his life <5590> for my sake and the gospel's, the same shall save it.
- Mark 8:36 For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul <5590>?
- Mark 8:37 Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul <5590>?
- Mark 10:45 For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life <5590> a ransom for many.

- Mark 12:30 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul <5590>, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.
- Mark 12:33 And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul <5590>, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbour as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.
- Mark 14:34 And saith unto them, My soul <5590> is exceeding sorrowful unto death: tarry ye here, and watch.
- Luke 1:46 And Mary said, My soul <5590> doth magnify the Lord,
- Luke 2:35 (Yea, a sword shall pierce through thy own soul <5590> also,) that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed.
- Luke 6:9 Then said Jesus unto them, I will ask you one thing; Is it lawful on the sabbath days to do good, or to do evil? to save life <5590>, or to destroy it?
- Luke 9:24 For whosoever will save his life <5590> shall lose it: but whosoever will lose his life <5590> for my sake, the same shall save it.
- Luke 9:56 For the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives <5590>, but to save *them*. And they went to another village.
- Luke 10:27 And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul <5590>, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.
- Luke 12:19 And I will say to my soul <5590>, Soul <5590>, thou hast much goods laid up for many years; take thine ease, eat, drink, and be merry.
- Luke 12:20 But God said unto him, *Thou* fool, this night thy soul <5590> shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?
- Luke 12:22 And he said unto his disciples, Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life <5590>, what ye shall eat; neither for the body, what ye shall put on.
- Luke 12:23 The life <5590> is more than meat, and the body is more than raiment.
- Luke 14:26 If any *man* come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life <5590> also, he cannot be my disciple.
- Luke 17:33 Whosoever shall seek to save his life <5590> shall lose it; and whosoever shall lose his life shall preserve it.
- Luke 21:19 In your patience possess ye your souls <5590>.
- John 10:11 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life <5590> for the sheep.

- John 10:15 As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life <5590> for the sheep.
- John 10:17 Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life <5590>, that I might take it again.
- John 10:24 Then came the Jews round about him, and said unto him, How long dost thou make us to doubt <5590>? If thou be the Christ, tell us plainly.
- John 12:25 He that loveth his life <5590> shall lose it; and he that hateth his life <5590> in this world shall keep it unto life eternal.
- John 12:27 Now is my soul <5590> troubled; and what shall I say? Father, save me from this hour: but for this cause came I unto this hour.
- John 13:37 Peter said unto him, Lord, why cannot I follow thee now? I will lay down my life <5590> for thy sake.
- John 13:38 Jesus answered him, Wilt thou lay down thy life <5590> for my sake? Verily, verily, I say unto thee, The cock shall not crow, till thou hast denied me thrice.
- John 15:13 Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life <5590> for his friends.

Chapter

6

The Scriptures - Epistles

- Acts 2:27 Because thou wilt not leave my soul <5590> in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.
- Acts 2:31 He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul <5590> was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption.
- Acts 2:41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added *unto them* about three thousand souls <5590>.
- Acts 2:43 And fear came upon every soul <5590>: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles.
- Acts 3:23 And it shall come to pass, that every soul <5590>, which will not hear that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people.

- Acts 14:22 Confirming the souls <5590> of the disciples, and exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God.
- Acts 15:24 Forasmuch as we have heard, that certain which went out from us have troubled you with words, subverting your souls <5590>, saying, Ye must be circumcised, and keep the law: to whom we gave no such commandment:
- Acts 15:26 Men that have hazarded their lives <5590> for the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Acts 20:10 And Paul went down, and fell on him, and embracing him said, Trouble not yourselves; for his life <5590> is in him.
- Acts 20:24 But none of these things move me, neither count I my life <5590> dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God.

- Acts 27:10 And said unto them, Sirs, I perceive that this voyage will be with hurt and much damage, not only of the lading and ship, but also of our lives <5590>.
- Acts 27:22 And now I exhort you to be of good cheer: for there shall be no loss of *any man*'s life <5590> among you, but of the ship.
- Acts 27:37 And we were in all in the ship two hundred threescore and sixteen souls <5590>.
- Romans 2:9 Tribulation and anguish, upon every soul <5590> of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile;

- I Corinthians 15:45 And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul <5590>; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit.
