October 1 | GULF REGION

Pray for a week-long Annual Pastors and Lay Workers Conference, being held in the Gulf region. Pray for the speakers and the 200+ pastors who are expected to attend.

October 2 | MALAYSIA

The presence of the anti-apostasy law has posed enormous challenges for Christians to spread the gospel message. Please pray for wisdom and courage for church leaders in reaching out to their neighbors.

October 3 | INDONESIA

Please pray for a national gathering of workers that will be held this month. Many are in need of encouragement and fellowship, especially given the hazardous nature of their work.

October 4 | CENTRAL ASIA

Pray for the churches that Open Doors works together with in Syria. They put a major effort in helping the internally displaced people and helping the other needy Syrians.

October 9 | CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC

Since December 2012, CAR has been going through a crisis brought about by the Seleka rebellion. As many continue to come to grips with the terrible losses they have faced, pray that they would trust in Jesus and that He would provide in their every need.

October 10 | NORTH KOREA

Continue to pray for Christians who have escaped from North Korea. Many live in constant fear of being repatriated back to North Korea.

October 13 | KENYA

Pray for Claris Mathole who lost her husband Pastor Charles Mathole on October 19, 2013, when suspected al-Shabaab terrorists shot him dead inside their church. Pray that God will continue to comfort her.

October 14 | CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC

Pray for Tatiana Kado, a widow left to care for two children after Seleka forces killed her husband. The rebels prevented the family from burying the body. Pray that the Lord will heal her and provide for her.

October 19 | TUNISIA

The Church in Tunisia is slowly growing. Pray for the new believers, that they find the right people to disciple them.
