May 3 | CENTRAL ASIA

A pastor has been harassed by police consistently for the past several months because of his ministry. Pray for his safety.

May 4 | ETHIOPIA

Pastors in rural areas can face threats aimed at both their families and churches. Pray for their safety.

May 5 | IRAQ

Pray for leaders and pastors who are preparing to care for refugees in the summer months. Pray for wisdom and for their needs to be met.
